

[the organic mushroom] by hilary hunt

a purl studio knit.

A chic, organic hat to match your holy cowl and gloves. Ready?, grab the following and get going...

Yarn: one skein of Lion Brand Nature's Choice organic cotton (this hat: walnut)

Needles: size 10 and size 11 circular needles (16")
-an interchangeable set works great! &
size 11 double pointed needles

Notions: one stitch marker

Using the size 10 circular needles, cast on 48.
Place a stitch marker to mark the end of row and join to knit in the round .

Work in a 1 x 1 Rib (K1, P1) until the brim of the hat measures 2 ½".

Increase Row: Switch to size 11 needles
M1, Knit 4 repeat ** to end of row, M1.
(61 stitches total).

Start the lace pattern:

Row 1: K1, *yo, K3tog, yo, knit 3*, repeat ** to end of row .

Row 2: Knit

Row 3: Knit 4, *yo, K3tog, yo, knit 3*, repeat ** to last 3 stitches; yo, k3tog, yo.

Row 4: Knit

Repeat lace pattern another 4 times.

Repeat rows 1 & 2 of lace again then start decreases.

Decrease: K1, *K3tog, yo, K3tog*, repeat ** to end of row.

Next row: Knit

Decrease: K1, *K3tog, yo, K3tog*, repeat ** to last stitch, K1.

Next row: Knit

Decrease: K1, *K3tog, yo, K3tog*, repeat ** to last stitch, K1.

Next row: Knit

Decrease: K3tog; repeat to last 2, K2tog.

Cut a long tail and thread it through remaining stitches several times to finish.
